Player Meetings:

- All players will have zoom calls with their team coach prior to the start of training.
- We expect all players on the team to be at Zoom orientation meeting to reconnect in preparation for being back on the field together before our first practice and to go over the expectations for the year.
- COVID-19 protocol for players will also be addressed in this meeting.

Regular Season Training Schedules:

- PSC training will begin at Pine Trails Park in August.
- At the end of August, training will be moved to Terramar Park. The City will provide a specific date when fields are ready at Terramar.
- The regular season training schedule will be finalized and posted on-line by August 5th.

League Updates:

- The FL Club League and Florida United Soccer Alliance Leagues are both scheduled to start on Sept. 12th.

- Schedules have not been posted as yet, but your team manager and coach will notify you when they are posted.
